Snow! Bring it Inside!



Place snow in a shallow bucket or tray, put it on the high chair, or on layered

towels, blankets, and a plastic table cloth or shower curtain. Add play toys and let the children have fun!



The variety of objects and toys is endless! Add a different variety each week.

Create an Ice cream parlour, construction site, dinosaur land, little pony shop, diamond dig, forest, and barn yard. Add shovels, spoons, scoops and funnels, plastic jewels, cars, trucks ,little people , and animals.













Children are little explorers. They learn science with longer play; watching the snow soften and melt and see it's changing properties. They manipulate it and develop hand-eye coordination. Dramatic play increases their social skills and vocabulary.
