Dinosaur Activities



Hints: combine colours for learning-eg.1 part green to 1 part blue gel. Don't crack open till you are ready to take a picture and eat them!

Making Dinosaur eggs: 1: boil eggs as usual. 2. Crack the cooled eggs by rolling around on a table (children can help). Keep the shell on the egg. 3. In the fridge. Soak the eggs overnight in 3 cups hot water, one tbsp gel food colouring, and one tbsp vinegar 4. The colour seeps through the cracks in the eggshells leaving coloured veining.

<u>Dinosaur Frozen Eggs</u>: Put small dinosaur toys inside balloons and fill with water (food colouring optional) and tie a knot. Freeze. When frozen pull off the balloon and discard. Using spray bottles filled with salt water, hammers and safety goggles, dig for your baby dinosaurs!





Jello Dinosaur Dig: Place jello in shallow pan following package directions. Add clean small dinosaur toys to jello as it's setting over night. Offer spoons for digging but they will probably use their hands! Enjoy!
